### **What is HAZWOPER?**

Auberle's HAZWOPER program trains young people for careers in environmental protection and clean-up services. The HAZWOPER program ends with a young person acquiring an OSHA HAZWOPER certification that is required for any type of job in the environmental field. This program will prepare you to respond to hazardous waste spills - everything from a tanker truck turnover to a derailed train as well as testing for air quality, towing and transporting hazardous items and oil spill clean-ups. This is a free 12-week program.

### **What Are The Benefits And Who Will Hire Me?**

Auberle has a partnership with Weavertown Environmental Group, the leading company in environmental protection services. A Weavertown trainer teaches the class and provide hands-on instruction to participants. Weavertown is interested in hiring all candidates who successfully complete Auberle's HAZWOPER program and earn their certification. Those who successfully complete the program will be given an application and opportunity to apply for this well-respected and growing company. Jobs in this field are in-demand and well-paying. Starting salaries for entry-level positions range from \$10-\$15/hour with opportunities to advance in the company. Employees receive free health benefits.
