What kind of jobs could I get hired for at UPMC through the POWRR program?

POWRR candidates can apply for any available position within UPMC, but UPMC is particularly looking to hire for the following positions:

- Dietary
- Nurse's Aid
- Nursing Assistant
- Patient Transporters
- Environmental Services

What steps do I have to take to complete the POWRR program?

Enroll in Auberle's Employment Institute and indicate that you are interested in working for UPMC and going through the POWRR program. You will complete three sessions:

1. Skills assessment - Are you ready for the job?
2. Getting the job- About the interview process
3. UPMC overview- About UPMC and their values

Once you complete all three sessions, you are POWRR certified for six months and can apply for a position at UPMC. POWRR candidates are given a "leg-up" and receive step-by-step support through the application process.

What is the benefit?

You will have the opportunity to apply with one of the largest, most well-respected companies in the region. You will receive training on exactly what UPMC is looking for in their employees, how to go through their application process and receive support from Auberle and UPMC. If hired through the POWRR program, you can apply for education and training programs which are paid for by UPMC to advance your career.
