Eligibility requirements for the Youth Zone are: youth ages 16-23 years of age who have had a 30 day placement in a child welfare after their 14th birthday and were adjudicated dependent or youth experiencing unstable housing.

We connect youth to resources to help them achieve their individual goals. Our areas of support and services include:

- Legal Aid

- Job Readiness and Workforce Development
- Financial assistance with state IDs, birth certificates, drivers training, and other crucial needs
