- Emergency Shelter- 30-60 day shelter to single women and women with dependent children
- <u>Bridge Housing</u>- families can remain for 3 months to 1 year. Residents pay 30% of their income and receive counseling in budget management and life skills.
- <u>Transitional Housing</u>- Women who have resided in the emergency shelter and bridge housing can move to this program for up to 2 years. Residents pay 30% of their income as rent.
 Transitional housing residents are required to be in school or working while in the program.
