




You qualify for **FREE** public transportation to get to your appointments if you:

- 1 **Live in Allegheny County**
- 2 **Receive Medical Assistance Insurance**
- 3 **Need to see a doctor, dentist, therapist or pharmacist**

Many social service agencies, medical centers, or the Travelers Aid main office can tell you how to sign up for the Medical Assistance Transportation Program (MATP).

FREE public transportation will begin once you are signed up with MATP and are determined to be eligible.

Travelers Aid and MATP work together with neighborhood social service agencies and medical facilities, providing **FREE** public transportation for adults and kids.
